



Hair: Natural and free flowing braids, curls, straight etc. If

necessary, little girls may wear 1 coordinating hair bow. **No balls and berets.** There will not be time to change

styles and accessories.

Makeup: Professional cosmetic artists will provide age-appropriate make-up.

Nails: Fingernails and toenails must be neatly manicured with clear polish

Skin: Moisturize your entire body / Use clear deodorant

Model's Bag: Bobby pins, Safety pins, lotion, aspirin, baby wipes,

tissue, and extra stockings or socks, mirror
